

## T - Chart

**T**-charts can be used for different purposes. (See the Tip Sheet “T-Charts for Active Reading.”) In general, something from the text (a quote, paraphrase, or summary) goes on the left, and some kind of response from you goes on the right. Depending on your purpose, you can respond in a variety of ways:

- a definition
- a connection to your experience
- an emotion (surprise, confusion, disagreement)
- a question
- a prediction
- a doodle or picture
