

YUBA COLLEGE – BEALE AIR FORCE BASE SECURITY INFORMATION RELEASE AND AGREEMENT FORM

Yuba College welcomes civilian students to the Beale Air Force Base Center. As guests of Beale Air Force Base, civilian students must meet specific requirements to gain admission to Beale Air Force Base. Due to the post September 11, 2001 threat environment, 9th Security Forces Squadron Pass and Registration has implemented more stringent security measures in the approval process and daily procedures relating to civilian student access to Beale Air Force Base.

After reading the information below, civilian students are required to provide signature and a valid Driver’s License or State Identification number.

- Civilian students enrolled in Beale Air Force Base Center classes are required to submit a valid Driver’s License or State Identification number at the time of registration. The student name, residency status and driver’s license number will be submitted to Beale Air Force Base Security Forces personnel. Security Forces will complete a security check on each student, running the identification number through police channels, searching for outstanding wants and warrants. **Students with outstanding wants and warrants will be denied access to Beale Air Force Base and may face arrest if attempting to enter.**
- Civilian students may obtain their base pass from five (5) days prior through five (5) days following the beginning of the term. **Students who do not obtain passes during the ten-day period will not have access to Beale Air Force Base.**
- Civilian students will be allowed to enter Beale Air Force Base through the Main Gate (North Beale Road) entrance only.
- When approaching the gate (on initial visit), students will be required to park outside the gate in the lot to the left, walk to the guard shack and present the following:
 - Current student schedule
 - Photo identification (current driver’s license)
 - Current vehicle registration
 - Proof of insurance

Upon verifying proper documentation, Security Forces Personnel will issue a temporary pass and vehicle permit, allowing the student to enter the base. The student will then be required to report to the Education Center, located at 17849 16th Street, where DD Form 1172, Application for Uniformed Services Identification Card will be issued. The student must proceed to Base Pass and Registration, located at 17855 Warren Shingle Blvd. where upon presentation of the documentation listed above, the student will receive a photo identification card and a vehicle pass. These documents will be issued for the length of the semester, and must be returned to Yuba College at the end of the student’s Beale Center enrollment

- While on Beale Air Force Base, civilian students must proceed directly to and from the Education Center when traveling to and from class. Students will not deviate from the direct route of travel or attempt to access Beale Air Force Base during unauthorized periods. Students who deviate from the direct route of travel, lose student access privileges to Beale Air Force Base. If a student is caught out of the direct route of travel, the student will have their pass immediately seized by on duty Security Forces personnel. Furthermore, the student access privileges to Beale Air Force Base will be revoked and will be escorted off the installation. Students will be allowed to walk to the bowling alley which is located directly behind the Education Center (for food purposes, not recreation) during their posted class times only.
