#### **ACCJC Accreditation Site Visit at Yuba College on October 8-11, 2018**

MARYSVILLE, CA. Yuba College will welcome the Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges (ACCJC), one of six regional accrediting organizations in the United States, on October 8-11, 2018. The ACCJC accredits private and public colleges that provide students two-year educational programs and confer associate degrees.

Yuba College is scheduled to host the ACCJC team of 10 faculty and administrators from peer colleges within the California Community College system for a site visit. The team is tasked with validating Yuba College's self-evaluation report and then reporting its findings to the Commission for deliberation and determination of continued accreditation status. During the site visit, the team will tour Yuba College's campuses; listen to feedback from internal and external communities of the College; and meet with students, faculty, staff, and administrators.

Yuba College has been actively engaged in the self-evaluation process for over two years and submitted its self-evaluation report to the Commission in early August. This was an extensive review where the college community examined its effectiveness and made plans for improvement in the context of the ACCJC's policies and standards. Upon the team's arrival in October, a brief welcome reception will be held on Monday, October 8. During this session, the team will introduce themselves and describe the site visit process.

On Tuesday, October 9 and Wednesday, October 10, community forums will be held at Yuba College and Sutter County Center in order for students, faculty, staff, and the public to provide the visiting team with feedback about the College.

The site visit will close with a brief exit session on Thursday, October 11. The team will recap their visit and provide preliminary commendations and recommendations.

All sessions and forums are open to students, faculty, staff, and members of the public.
